It has been a busy time at Bakhita and we are so proud of our efforts in serving survivors of human trafficking. Over the 9 months, we have been tracking our efforts and are proud to share updates with you.

Since Bakhita opened its doors in 2021

30 live in residents.

Over 92,000 safe residential hours combined (3,833 Safe Nights).

Provided services to over 150 non-resident survivors.

Since we began tracking services provided starting in September 2024, Bakhita staff have provided over 500 services to our current residents. Join us at our signature events, including our new fundraising gala- Echoes of Courage.
